

☐ Hormel Institute

Tour the newly expanded \$31.5 million Hormel Institute. A world leader in cancer research through the study of food agents and cell functions now offers pre-arranged tours. Experience a 3D simulation of molecules and possibly sample cancer prevention foods.



■ Mower County Historical Society

Artifacts and historical items in 16 buildings include one of the original Hormel Buildings, where George Hormel started the company. Also be sure to check out the vintage firefighting equipment, horse-drawn carriages, a steam locomotive, caboose, one room school house, a Civil War flag and more.



☐ Jay C. Hormel Nature Center

Explore over \$1 million in new exhibits at the Interpretive Center in addition to enjoying hardwood and pine forests, restored prairies, creeks, ponds, and scenic walking trails, and/or programs on cider pressing, maple syruping, monarch tagging, astronomy, birds of prey, bird banding, prairie chicken mating dance and more presented by the Nature Center staff.



□ SPAM® Museum

One of Minnesota's top FREE attractions, newly opened in 2016 featuring audios, videos and displays depicting the rich history of Hormel Foods in a tour that is interactive, educational, and fun for all ages. Also since the SPAM® Museum is downtown you can discover many other attractions within walking distance. **Sweet Reads**, a classic bookstore with old fashion candy is directly across the street or **Rydjor Bike Museum**, displays the history of bicycles on 16 foot walls inside the shop, each of the 84 bicycles has its own story beginning with the 1868 "Boneshaker" View the evolution of bicycles up to the most current style.



☐ Hormel Historic Home

Discover the stately 14-room home of the George A Hormel family (founder of Hormel Foods Corp). Built in 1871, the home features stained glass windows, decorative woodwork, front pillars imported from Italy, Tiffany light fixtures and a Greek marble fireplace.



☐ Austin City Tour

☐ Paramount Theatre

The Historic Paramount Theatre, 1 of only 4 "Atmospheric Theatres" remaining in Minnesota. Opened in 1929 it was designed for stage theatre and first run movies. The Paramount was designed to represent being in a courtyard of a quaint Spanish Village with twinkling stars and rolling clouds overhead. Fully restored to its original grandeur, this functioning theatre will be available for your group to select and view a movie or live entertainment from a wide variety of options.



☐ Austin ArtWorks Center

Make it memorable by creating your own holiday ornament. Let your creative side come alive and have an incredible masterpiece to take home. (no experience necessary)

☐ Sterling Shopping Center

AGRICULTURE IDEA ADD-ON'S

☐ Al-Corn Clean Fuel Ethanol Plant

Annually Al-Corn grinds 17.5 million bushels of corn, producing 50 million gallons of ethanol, as well as 132,000 tons of high protein livestock feed, 12 million pounds of corn oil, and 70,000 tons of beverage grade carbon dioxide.



☐ Four Daughters Vineyard

Savor the beautiful views of the vineyards while sipping a glass of on-site produced sparkling and estate varietal wines side by side. The focus is on education for both new tasters and wine connoisseurs alike.

☐ Farmer John's

Tour a working fruit and vegetable farm. Horse drawn carriage around the property may also be arranged.

☐ Wind Farm Tour

The Austin area is well known for being a major player in the Wind Industry. There are multiple wind farms in the area with over 1,500 wind turbines total. Visit a farm and learn why wind power is currently the fastest-growing source of electricity production in the world.



☐ Alpacas Of Oak Knoll Farms

View over 60 alpacas at Alpacas of Oak Knoll Farms as they graze the lawn. Alpaca fur has as many as 22 colors that can be made into various clothing items or blankets.
